<u>Guidelines for Cancellation of Bus Runs-</u> <u>Schools Open:</u>

A decision to cancel bus runs will be announced by 6am. Communication will be as aforementioned.

Guidelines for Delayed Opening of School

On school days when conditions exist that is not safe to open school at the regularly scheduled time but it is predicted that conditions will improve, a **2 hour** delayed opening may be considered. Delayed openings would be considered when a severe weather event has concluded but snow clearing or other operations require additional time. Delayed opening may also be considered when the physical plant is experiencing an issue (power, water) and additional time is requited to prepare the school for opening. In the event of a delayed opening the following will apply:

- School opening will be delayed 2 hours
- School bus pick up times will be delayed 2 hours.
- Excel child care will be delayed opening 2 hours
- Lunch times will not change
- Afternoon class schedules will not change
- Dismissal time will not change
